Do not pack important documents in your checked luggage. Always carry your LOE, medical documents, licenses, and training certificates with you.

Contact the airline to learn about luggage restrictions, including: the allowed number of bags, weight limitations, and acceptable items that can be taken on board the flight.



Make sure you carry enough cash or a major credit card to cover any potential luggage fees. Keep receipts to submit them for reimbursement. The Company will provide reimbursement for any baggage fees up to a maximum of the first 30 Kilos. The 30 kilos is inclusive of the allowance that is provided by the airline. Example: if the carrier provides a baggage allowance of **20 kilos**, **RCG** will cover fees for up to **10 additional kilos**.



The Company will not reimburse for excess size or for a weight penalty, so pack carefully.
